RE: Project Ordinance Revisions for Construction of New and Replacement Schools

The Board of County Commissioners approved project ordinances for the 2020 \$300 million dollar bond referendum on April 15, 2021, and on January 5, 2023, for the 2022 \$1.7 billion bond referendum projects. The amount of each project ordinance was based on the budget for the project included in the Guilford County Schools Master Facilities Plan issued in 2019.

The initial ordinance for projects in the table below includes enough funding through the end of the design phase for each project. Staff requests an increase to the ordinances as outlined in the table below to fund early release work Guaranteed Maximum Prices (GMPs), which include hazard materials abatement, demolition, sitework and utility infrastructure, pre-purchase of long lead materials and equipment for each project listed below.

On June 10, 2025 the BOE approved revised project ordinances as listed below:
