

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE GUILFORD COUNTY BOARD OF
COMMISSIONERS TO APPOINT EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION (ETJ)
MEMBER TO THE GIBSONVILLE PLANNING BOARD**

WHEREAS, Section 9-2.2 of the Gibsonville Development Ordinance states that “The Planning Board shall consist of seven (7) members of the town, two (2) Guilford County ETJ representatives, one (1) Alamance County ETJ representative, and may have at least two (2) alternates, appointed by the Governing Body. Extraterritorial members and alternates shall be appointed as provided by North Carolina General Statutes.”; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. §160D-307(a) states that as a result of extraterritorial jurisdiction, a means of proportional representation based on population for residents of the extraterritorial area shall be provided, which requires that the local Board of County Commissioners serves to appoint members living in the Town’s extraterritorial jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Gibsonville is requesting the appointment of the following individual to serve as Extraterritorial Jurisdiction representative to the following board:

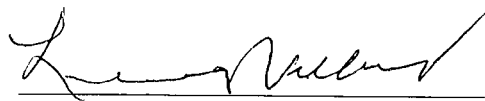

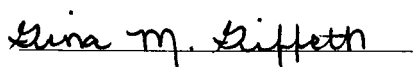
