On October 14, 2025, the Guilford County Board of Education declared as surplus approximately 11.73 acres of property located at 7911 Summerfield Road, Summerfield, NC.

In accordance with NC General Statutes §§ 160A, 115C-518, and 115C-426, the Board of Education now offers the Board of County Commissioners the first opportunity to obtain this property by the exercise of its right of first refusal. If the Board of County Commissioners does not choose to purchase this property, the Board of Education intends to sell this property to the highest bidder using a negotiated bid procedure and requests that the clear proceeds from such sale be applied to the purchase of the Green Valley Central Office facility in accordance with the INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT REGARDING THE PURCHASE AND FUNDING FOR GCS CENTRAL OFFICE SITE adopted by the Guilford County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) on March 21, 2024.
