## RESOLUTION NAME: INTERLOCAL ADDRESSING AGREEMENT WITH GUILFORD COUNTY

**WHEREAS,** North Carolina General Statute Section 160A-174 authorizes municipalities to regulate acts, omissions, or conditions detrimental to the health safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, North Carolina General Statute Section 160A–296 specifically provides, that municipalities have general authority and control over all public streets, sidewalks, alleys, bridges and other ways of public passage within their corporate limits, except to the extent authority and control over certain streets and bridges is vested in the Board of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statute Section 160A-461 authorizes local governments to enter into agreements with each other in order to execute contracts or agreements with each other in order to execute any undertaking; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Summerfield (the "Town") desires to enter into an agreement concerning the shared responsibilities of the Town and Guilford County for the purposes of street addressing (the "Interlocal Addressing Agreement"); and

**WHEREAS**, a copy of the Interlocal Addressing Agreement is attached to this Resolution and is hereby incorporated into this instrument by reference as if copied fully herein; and

**WHEREAS**, the provisions and requirements in this Interlocal Addressing Agreement apply only to the corporate limits of the Town and any extraterritorial planning jurisdiction of the Town within Guilford County; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Summerfield that the attached Interlocal Addressing Agreement is hereby approved.

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that that the Town Manager is authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Town.
