Five grandsons, and three granddaughters. I have served as a volunteer at the Hamilton County Juvenile Detention center in Cincinnati Ohio, through Intentional Means LLC, I have worked with children for many years, as a school bus driver in Cincinnati, Ohio for First Student, I taught sixth grade Science as a substitute at TMSA in Greensboro, NC. I work with the adolescents at Old Vineyard behavioral Health in Winston Salem North Carolina. I understand the challenges that many our children face in today's society which more than often times shapes their perspectives and determines the choices and paths that they will follow. There are many children who did not have a choice and were born into dysfunctional situations filled with extensive levels of traumatic experiences. As a result, we in our communities are affected, by the traumas of many of these children whose trauma has never been addressed, or simply written off as "Bad Behaviors". When helping the children that I have encountered throughout my journey I try to take into consideration this Model, "Maslow's Hierarchy of needs". I look at the entire picture, and I have often come to discover, that at least one or more of these needs in these children's lives are not met. If we want to see a decrease in crime, and crime prevention, we must have a plan in place to combat or minimize these traumatic experiences and vicious cycles that many of our youth are experiencing. Yes, it does begin at home, and often these are generational traumas. The question would be, how we serve the family as a whole, to create a healthier environment for our future? I know that my experiences, and compassion to see our youth not just survive, but thrive would allow me to serve on this board with conviction and clarity in my heart.
