RE: Project Ordinance Revisions for Construction of New and Replacement Schools and

Deferred Capital Replacement Projects

The Board of County Commissioners approved project ordinances for the 2020 \$300 million dollar bond referendum on April 15, 2021, and on January 5, 2023, for the 2022 \$1.7 billion bond referendum projects.

The district has completed and opened several comprehensive projects since the ordinance approvals. Staff recommend transferring the remainder of available balances from the comprehensive projects at Brooks Global and Claxton Elementary Schools, as well as deferred capital projects at Cone and Florence elementary schools to new and existing deferred capital projects.

On September 9, 2025, the Board of Education approved revised project ordinance as listed below.
