PROBLEM



PROBLEM 1

Complexity of child abuse and elder abuse cases involving multi-agency response has exploded due to COVID

PROBLEM 2

DSS investigators caseloads are 120% over the state average- impacting staff turnover and the ability to collaborate

PROBLEM 3

Only one CPS worker at both FJCs and one APS worker split between sites- limits partnership ability




DSS STATS

From 2019-2022:

21% increase in child abuse reports
30% increase in cases accepted

11% increase in elder abuse reports
24% increase in cases accepted
