I am very familiar with rescue organizations and set up a non-profit that among other things funds rescue of Kerry Blue Terriers nationwide and serve on its Board. I believe that education is a key to reducing homeless pets. Pit Bulls constitute the largest intake at the Shelter and reaching out to those who own them is an imperative to reducing their numbers. The school program started in Guilford County by Ruby Wescott is worthy of support as it does reach into a broad base of our community teaching responsible pet ownership.
