

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF INTERLOCAL AGREEMENTS PERTAINING TO THE PROVISION OF ANIMAL SHELTER AND ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES BY GUILFORD COUNTY TO THE CITIES OF GREENSBORO AND HIGH POINT, AND THE TOWNS OF GIBSONVILLE, OAK RIDGE, PLEASANT GARDEN, SEDALIA, STOKESDALE, SUMMERFIELD, AND WHITSETT.

WHEREAS, N.C. General Statute § 160A-461, “Interlocal cooperation authorized,” authorizes units of local government to enter into agreements with each other in order to execute an undertaking by one unit of local government on behalf of another unit of local government; and

WHEREAS, each of the above captioned Cities and Towns wish to enter into individual agreements with Guilford County, by which Guilford County has agreed to provide certain animal shelter and/or control services to each of the above captioned Cities and Towns, pursuant to the attached Interlocal Agreements, and doing so is in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Guilford County Board of County Commissioners does hereby ratify and authorize, in substantial form, each of the attached Interlocal Agreements between Guilford County and each of the following Cities and Towns: Greensboro, High Point, Gibsonville, Oak Ridge, Pleasant Garden, Sedalia, Stokesdale, Summerfield, and Whitsett. The Guilford County Manager or an Assistant County Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached Interlocal Agreements, in substantial form. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes.
