To the Guilford County Board of Commissioners,

The Guilford County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council (JCPC) is requesting exemption from the two (2) term limit for Ms. Latisha McNeil and recommending reappointment for a third term. Ms. McNeil has regularly attended scheduled meetings and served the Guilford County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council since August 22, 2019 and she continues to be a valued member of our council.

The Guilford County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council provides a valuable, mandated service to Guilford County's community, youth and their families. The level of skill and dedication required for this council presents a challenge when recruiting members. We rely on seasoned members, such as Ms. McNeil, to provide the level of knowledge and dedication required to successfully administer the duties as an effective member of the Guilford County JCPC. Ms. McNeil has offered to serve JCPC again and she provides great insight as a Criminal Justice Administrator for the City of Greensboro and has experience as a former staff member in the juvenile detention center which has been extremely helpful with JCPC. The council has agreed to her serving again, if her term can be extended.

Again, we respectfully request Ms. Latisha McNeil's term limits be waived and recommend reappointment for a third term on the Guilford County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council.
