I volunteered with Brother Wolf Animal Rescue 5-7 years ago. I'd walk dogs and wash dog bowls after mealtimes. I adopted my dog from the Asheville Humane Society, with parvo. It happens. She pulled through, YAY! I would like to see Guilford County develop Animal Services in a number of ways. First, I would like Animal Services to be more visible to the public through social media, organized events and fundraisers, and special campaigns/drives for specific needs, such as a business-sponsorship drive and/or 5k for kuranda beds. We also need prominent community education in place regarding training and in-home placement for adoptees, and spay/neuter requirements should be prominent in our community as well. I'd also like for the county to take a long, hard look at the structure and staffing of the shelter, in order to reallocate manpower/funds to areas that we need. For example, upon recent visits to the shelter, I regularly greet front desk staff when I enter. There can be four-plus people at the front desks idly playing cell phone games or surfing the internet, but only one to two people in the back (who aren't volunteers) washing and cleaning kennels. Perhaps we could review front-end staffing, employ an electronic volunteer sign-in or spreadsheet with time-stamps, and redirect our human capital to begin dog training and grooming to improve a dog's chances at successful adoption.
