BACKGROUND

..Background

Section 3(d)(6) of the Enabling Act of the Piedmont Triad Airport Authority (the "Authority") authorizes the Authority to sell or convey real property that it owns, but the Act requires that any sale or conveyance by the Authority be first approved by the Board of Commissioners of Guilford County. The Authority has agreed, subject to the approval of the Commissioners and the FAA, to convey to the North Carolina Department of Transportation (the "NCDOT") three parcels of land that the agency needs in order to complete two road construction projects. The first parcel is a 0.744 acre tract that is to be incorporated into the I-73 project. The NCDOT will pay the Authority the sum of \$134,375.00 for this tract. The remaining parcels are a .059 acre parcel and a .020 acre parcel that are to be incorporated into a project to re-align Stage Coach Trail. The Authority has agreed to convey these tracts to the NCDOT without compensation. ..end

Dear Ms. Keller:

Our firm represents the Piedmont Triad Airport Authority. Recently, the Authority agreed to convey to the North Carolina Department of Transportation several parcels of land that are to be incorporated into various highway projects in the vicinity of the Airport. Section 3(d)(6) of the Enabling Act of the Authority authorizes it to sell or dispose of real property that belongs to it, but the Act requires that any sale of real property be first approved by the Board of County Commissioners of Guilford County. Thus, the proposed conveyances are subject to the approval of the County Commissioners.

On behalf of the Authority, we hereby request that consideration of this matter be added to the agenda of the meeting of Commissioners scheduled for February 23, 2017. In addition to the approval of the County Commissioners, the property transfers must be approved by the Federal Aviation Administration. The proposed conveyances are as follows:

Pleasant Ridge Road Property

The Authority recently agreed to sell to the NCDOT a 0.744 acre tract of land located on Pleasant Ridge Road for the sum of \$134,375.00. The NCDOT desires to acquire this tract from the Authority for the construction of the I-73 project. In July, 2014, the Authority conveyed to the NCDOT a 0.463 acre tract along Pleasant Ridge Road for this project. As a result of a

re-design of the road alignment, NCDOT needs the 0.744 acre tract that it now seeks to acquire. Upon completion of the I-73 project, a portion of the 0.463 acre tract previously conveyed to NCDOT will be re-conveyed to the Authority.

The 0.744 acre tract is described by metes and bounds on Exhibit A which is attached to this letter. In addition, we are attaching a map, designated as Exhibit B, upon which the tract to be conveyed is shown. The 0.744 acre tract to be conveyed is shown in yellow on Exhibit B, and the 0.463 acre tract previously conveyed is shown in blue.

Stage Coach Trail Property

The NCDOT desires to acquire two parcels of land, a .059 acre parcel and a .020 acre parcel, in connection with its efforts to re-align Stage Coach Trail. Given various benefits that the Authority will derive from the re-alignment of the road, it will transfer these parcels to the NCDOT without compensation. The parcels that are to be transferred are described by metes and bounds on Exhibit C which is attached hereto. We are also attaching a map, designated as Exhibit D, upon which the tracts to be conveyed are shown in red.

The Authority will retain some control over the use of the parcels conveyed by the inclusion in the deed transferring the tracts various restrictions required by the FAA, including restrictions on height of any structures that may be constructed on the property and the reservation of various avigation easements over the property. With the use of the parcels regulated in this manner, it will no longer be necessary for the Authority to retain actual ownership and possession of them.

Representatives of the Authority will be in attendance at the February 23rd meeting of the County Commissioners in order to provide any further information with regard to these transactions as the Commissioners may request. In the meantime, if additional information is required, please feel free to contact our office.

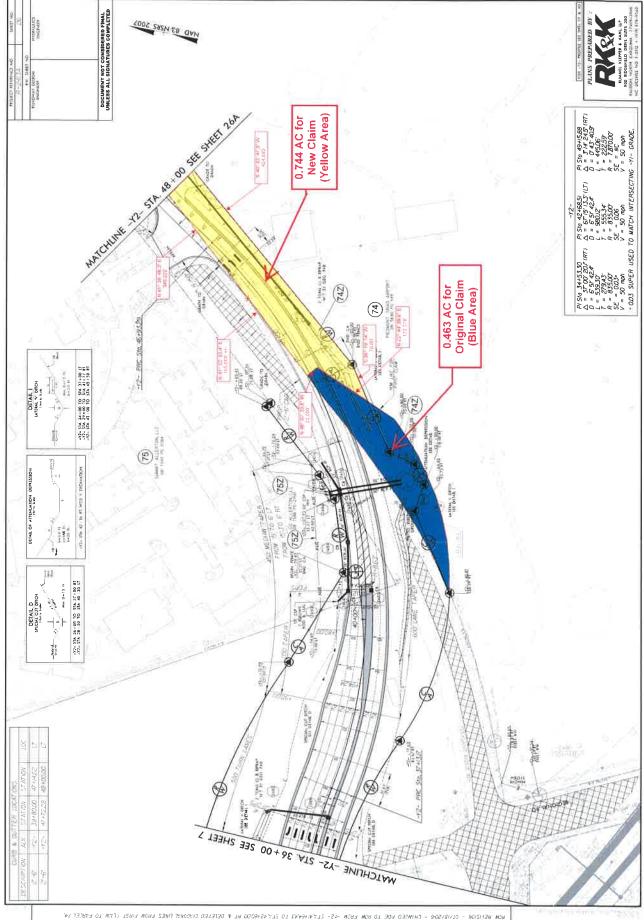

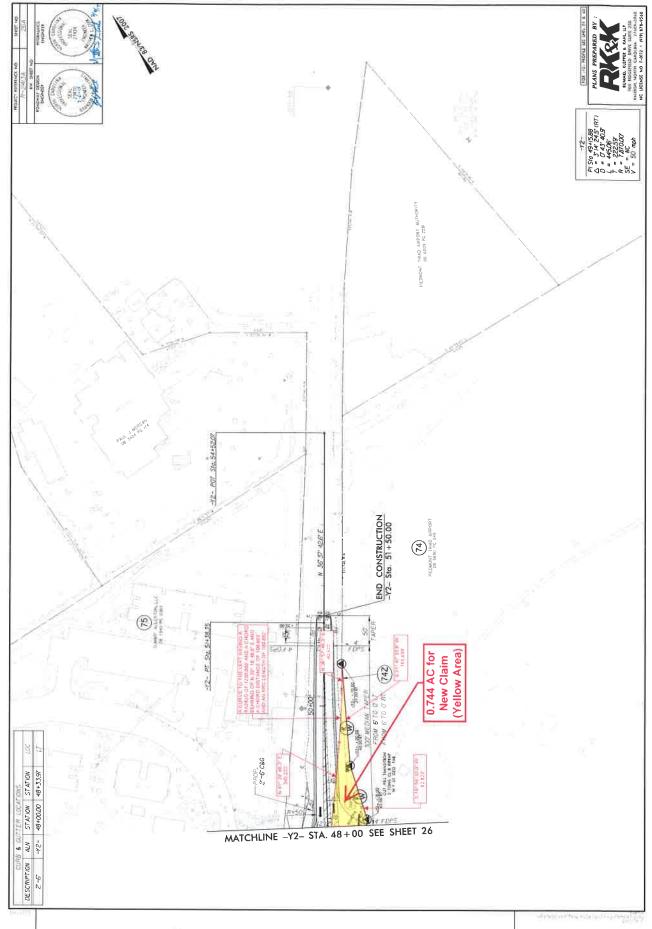
