# TEXT AMENDMENT CASE # 17-06-GCPL-03089

Text Amendment transferring approval powers of the Environmental Review Board to the Planning Board

The Guilford County Board of Commissioners at its FY17/18 Annual Retreat (10-Feb-17) voted to eliminate the Guilford County Environmental Review Board (ERB) and transfer approval authority of the ERB to the Guilford County Planning Board.

Amendments necessary for this change to the Guilford County General Development Ordinance are delineated with strikethroughs for text elimination and shading for new text.

# ARTICLE VII, Environmental Regulations

# 7-1.5 (F) (Appeals) Stormwater Management/Watershed Development Plan.

(F) Appeals: Appeals of the Enforcement Officer's decision on a Stormwater Management/Watershed Development plan shall be made in writing to the Environmental Review Board Planning Board. The Technical Review Committee shall review the appeal at its first regularly scheduled meeting after receipt of the written appeal and make a recommendation to the Environmental Review Board Planning Board.

# 7-1.10. Stream Channelization.

Perennial Streams in water supply district shall not be channelized without prior approval by the Environmental Review Board Planning Board.

#### 7-1.12. (A) (2) Variances.

(A) General:

2) For each request for a minor or major stormwater management/watershed variance, the Enforcement Officer shall notify all other local governments having jurisdiction within the same water supply

watershed or using the affected water supply for consumption. A comment period of at least fourteen (14) days shall be allowed before the Environmental Review Board Planning Board hearing.

#### 7-1.12. (A) (6) Variances.

6) Before the Environmental Review Board Planning Board or Governing Body may grant a minor watershed variance or recommend approval to the North Carolina Environmental Management Commission (EMC) for a major variance, it shall make the following three findings, and shall include the factual reasons on which they are based.

#### 7-1.12. (A) (2) a) i) Variances

- a) There are practical difficulties or unnecessary hardships in the way of carrying out the strict letter of the watershed requirements, and all of the following conditions exist:
  - i. If the applicant complies with the provisions of this rule, the applicant can secure no reasonable return from, nor make reasonable use of the subject property. Merely proving that the variance would permit a greater profit from the property shall not be considered adequate justification for a variance. Moreover, the EMC or Environmental Review Board Planning Board shall consider whether the variance is the minimum possible deviation from the terms of the rule that shall make reasonable use of property possible.

#### 7-1.12. (B) Minor Stormwater/Watershed Variances.

(B) Minor Stormwater/Watershed Variances: The Environmental Review Board Planning Board is designated to approve minor stormwater management and watershed variances. The Technical Review Committee (TRC) shall review the submitted request for consistency with the Map Standards in the Guilford County Development Ordinance prior to forwarding to the Environmental Review Board Planning Board for approval or denial. Any minor variance approved by the Environmental Review Board Planning Board may be appealed to the governing body within fifteen (15) days.

## 7-3.14. Appeal Hearing.

(A) Any person assessed a civil penalty under this chapter shall have the right to a hearing before the Environmental Review Board Planning Board upon making a written demand to ERB Planning Board specifying the issues to be contested, within thirty (30) days following receipt of the assessment.

#### 9-6. THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW BOARD

#### 9-6.1. Authority.

There is hereby created a planning agency, pursuant to NCGS 160A-361 or 153A-321 to be known as the Environmental Review Board.

#### 9-6.2. Membership.

The Environmental Review Board shall consist of at least seven (7) members and may have alternates, appointed by the Governing Body.

# 9-6.3. Powers and Duties.

The Environmental Review Board shall have the following powers and duties:

(A) Investigate environmental conditions of Guilford County periodically;

(B) Review regulatory procedures and methods of governmental units;
