**RE:** Project Ordinance Revisions – Smith High School Physical Education Improvements Project Ordinance

On December 12, 2017, the Board of Education (BOE) approved the transfer of \$290,501 to the Smith High School Physical Education Improvements project ordinance from the following project ordinances:

This transfer is necessary for the completion of two scope items. The first is the demolition and replacement of the visitors' stadium bleachers. The second is the installation of lighting at the track and practice field. The cost to complete both scopes of work is estimated to be \$763,201. The current available balance in the project is \$473,214.

The BOE is requesting that an item be placed on the consent agenda of first January 2018 meeting of the Guilford County Board of Commissioners seeking approval of the transfer cited above.
