The Guilford County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council (JCPC) is requesting exemption from the two (2) term limit for Mr. Marcus A. Jackson and recommending reappointment for another term. Mr. Jackson is the current JCPC Chairman and has served as the Juvenile Defense Attorney representative since his initial appointment in 2015.

The Guilford County JCPC provides a valuable, mandated service to Guilford County citizens, specifically our juvenile population and their families. The level of skill and dedication required for this council presents a challenge when recruiting volunteers. We rely on seasoned members, such as Mr. Jackson, to provide the level of knowledge and dedication required to successfully administer the responsibilities of an effective member of the JCPC.

Again, we respectfully request Mr. Marcus A. Jackson's term limits waived and recommend reappointment for a 3<sup>rd</sup> term on the Guilford County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council.
