Local Option Sales Tax Referendum

- <u>August 03, 2020</u> Commission notification to local & State Board of Elections to include advisory referendum on primary election ballot with specific ballot verbiage (90-120 days preferred)
- November 3, 2020 Obtain voter approval in non-binding advisory referendum
- <u>December 07, 2020</u> Provide 10 days public notice of intent to adopt resolution levying the new tax
- <u>December 17, 2020</u> Approve resolution levying new tax
- <u>December 30, 2020</u> Forward adopted resolution levying the tax to Department of Revenue
- April 01, 2021 Collection of revenue for ½% Sales Tax increase begins





Ballot Inclusion

- Use of funds <u>cannot</u> be included on the ballot. However, the Board of Commissioners may adopt a resolution stipulating the use of the proceeds.
- Ballot question must be presented as follows:

FOR

[] AGAINST

Local sales and use tax at the rate of one-quarter percent (0.25%) in addition to all other State and local sales and use taxes.
