APPROPRIATION TO FAMILY JUSTICE CENTER FOR CAMP HOPE GUILFORD COUNTY - \$25,000

BACKGROUND

In May 2016, the Family Justice Center (FJC) received a donation of \$15,000 from The Weaver Foundation and \$15,000 from The Verizon Foundation to assist with implementation of the Camp HOPE program in August 2017 within Guilford County. A portion of these funds are included in the FY 2017-18 budget towards camp supplies and provisions (\$1,500), and to cover the cost of Camp HOPE affiliation fees (\$3,500).

In July 2017, a final agreement was reached with the YMCA of Greensboro regarding the total number of camp participants, and the remaining unappropriated donated funds (\$25,000) will be used to cover fees, and associated camp expenses, for thirty-six (36) campers and ten (10) counselors attending the inaugural session of the Camp HOPE program in Guilford County, which will be held August 13-18, 2017 at the YMCA of Greensboro's Camp Weaver.

This resolution appropriates donated funds received last year into the current year's budget to Camp HOPE related fees and expenses.
