Proclamation Declaring November as World Pancreatic Cancer Awareness Month in Guilford County

WHEREAS, the cause of most pancreatic cancers continues to remain unknown where too often the subtle symptoms are attributed to lesser serious medical conditions that go undiagnosed until the disease has reached the late stages of progression; and

, pancreatic cancer has the lowest survival rate of all major cancers, and just 2 to 10 percent of those revive five years; and

, studies show that death rates for pancreatic cancer are increasing in the United States, while death lining for most other cancers; and

, pancreatic cancer is the seventh most common cause of cancer-related death in men and women orld and is the fourth leading cause of cancer-related death in developed countries, surpassing even in the United States, with an estimated 280,000 new cases of pancreatic cancer diagnosed each year;

, the good health and well-being of the residents of Guilford County are enhanced as a direct result of rareness about pancreatic cancer and research into early detection, causes, and effective treatments.

MORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Guilford County Board of Commissioners hopes to elevate and draw attention to pancreatic cancer in hopes of greater investment and interest in the disease, which ore people to be diagnosed in time for surgery - currently the only potential for a cure.
