**DHHS - PUBLIC HEALTH DIVISION BUDGET AMENDMENT - ESTABLISH FUND BALANCE CARE COORDINATION FOR CHILDREN**

### BACKGROUND

Guilford County Department of Health & Human Services - Public Health Division receives funds from Partnership for Community Care for Care Coordination for Children. These funds are based on monthly funding provided by the Division of Medical Assistance (DMA). Public Health receives these monthly calculated on the base population of the program, consisting of Medicaid beneficiaries ages 0-5. Public Health is requesting to establish a fund balance in the FY 2017 -2018 budget to include an \$430,445 increase in appropriated fund balance from prior fiscal years. The funder requires for Public Health to carry-over unspent, unobligated funds received in prior fiscal years. The exact amount will be determined during the fiscal year end closing period
