BACKGROUND

Cooperative Extension has received \$3,000 in funding from the NC Agriculture Foundation to support the FoodCorps program, which provides nutrition education and assists with sustainable gardening for Guilford County schools located within the City of High Point. This funding will assist with stipends for two (2) interns who offer Common Core and Essential Standards nutrition education through outdoor garden classrooms and cooking classes designed to engage children and their families.
