# **<u>TITLE</u>** MADDIE'S FUND GRANT RECEIPT AND BUDGET AMENDMENT

## BACKGROUND

Guilford County Animal Services has been awarded a grant of \$5,000 from Maddie's Fund to enable us to hire a part-time social media/public information consultant for 6 months (at an average of 15 hours per month). This part-time position will help Animal Services enter the 21st century in terms of engaging with the public on various real-time social media platforms--Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Tumblr, and live chat on our website. Our goal is to improve our social media presence; an underlying objective is to use this project to demonstrate convincingly to our community the positive impact of Animal Services. We believe it is time for Animal Services to establish a positive, professional, and effective presence on a variety of social media platforms to engage the public in helpful ways, and this grant request is our first step on this road.
