#### **TITLE**

RECOMMENDED ALLOCATION OF GUILFORD COUNTY JUVENILE CRIME PREVENTION COUNCIL (JCPC) FUNDS FOR FY 2020-21

## **BACKGROUND**

The Guilford County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council (JCPC) recommends an allocation of \$1,289,575 in NC Department of Public Safety funding and \$85,000 in County Match funding in the FY 2020-21 budget. Two (2) Request for Proposals (RFPs) for the use of funds within Guilford County were issued to qualified and evaluation processed community-based programs targeting delinquent or gang involved youth (ages 10-17), or those at risk of juvenile court involvement. Copies of the RFPs are attached. Twenty-seven (27) programs responded, and following a review of the RFPs, the JCPC voted on April 28, 2020 in favor of the previously stated allocation recommendation for FY 2020-21. A copy of the funding plan is attached.
