<u>TITLE</u> DHHS - DIVISION OF SOCIAL SERVICES LOW INCOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LIEAP)

BACKGROUND

Guilford DHHS-Division of Social Services has received an energy program funding authorization for FY 2021-22. Included in the funding authorization is additional energy funding to assist citizens of Guilford County residents with heating and cooling costs.

This fiscal year, funding was increased by \$528,657 for direct payments to energy vendors on behalf of eligible households and administrative funding increased by \$8,889.00, which is used to assist Guilford county DSS with administering the the program.

With the additional funding, Guilford's total program allocation is \$2,971,043.00 and \$399,137 for administration.
