The Guilford County Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) would like to request a Term Exemption for the current Health and Human Services Advisory Committee (HHSAC) member, Dr. Tanya Redd. Set forth in the HHSAC Bylaws, members have a two-term limit. With this request, we would like to recommend that Dr. Redd be granted a 3rd term as a member of the HHSAC.

HHSAC serves a key role in advocating for the health and well-being of the citizens of Guilford County. Dr. Redd has served on HHSAC since February 18th, 2021, and has served as the “Dentist” representative. At this time, we do not have any dentist candidates to fill the seat currently occupied by Dr. Redd. Dr. Redd is interested in continuing her service on HHSAC and her contributions to date have been greatly appreciated. At this time, we have several vacancies we are anticipating filling in the near-term. Dr. Redd’s continued presence would help with the onboarding and transition of members and bring valuable perspective and context as HHS continues its work in consolidating/integrating operations and service delivery across Public Health and Social Services.
