RE: Project Ordinance Revisions for Construction of New and Replacement Schools

The Board of County Commissioners approved project ordinances for the 2020 \$300 million dollar bond referendum on April 15, 2021, and on January 5, 2023, for the 2022 \$1.7 billion bond referendum projects.

The current ordinance for the Lindley Elementary Replacement School Project in the table below includes enough funding through the end of the design, early release work, and pre-purchase of long lead materials phases for the project. The project has bid, and we are requesting an ordinance increase as outlined below that provides access to the remainder of the project budget to fund construction through project completion.

On May 11, 2026, the Board of Education approved revised project ordinance as listed below.
