

MINUTES BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Greensboro, North Carolina
November 29, 1948

The Board of Commissioners of Guilford County met in adjourned regular session at 9:00 o'clock A. M. in the Commissioners' Room at the County Courthouse Greensboro, N. C. the regular place of meeting as per advertisements appearing in the Greensboro Daily News and High Point Enterprise.

Present: J. A. Doggett, Chairman, Charles J. Hunt, L. C. Amos, and William G. Ragsdale, Jr.

Also present: J. H. McAdoo, Clerk to Board, T. C. Hoyle, County Attorney, and J. Harry Weatherly, County Manager.

Absent: F. Logan Porter. Commissioner Porter notified Mr. Weatherly he could not attend this meeting as he would be out of the state.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and ordered approved.

Commissioner Ragsdale offered the following resolution and moved its adoption, this was seconded by Commissioner Hunt and the resolution was adopted by roll call vote as follows: Ayes: J. A. Doggett, Charles J. Hunt, L. C. Amos and William G. Ragsdale. Noes: None. Commissioner Hunt stated that Commissioner Porter said to him that he was heartily in favor of adopting the boundary commission report.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Report of the Commission consisting of C. W. Phillips, P. M. Davis, H. M. Robins, and W. L. Ward appointed by the County Commissioners of Guilford County and the County Commissioners of Randolph County under the provisions of G. S 153-11 to settle and fix the boundary line between Guilford County and Randolph County be and it is hereby ratified; and J. H. McAdoo, Register of Deeds of Guilford County is hereby ordered and directed to cause said report to be registered in his office; and Ralph D. Stout and Frank N. Phillips, Engineers, Trading and doing business as Southern Mapping and Engineering Company be, and they are hereby employed and authorized and directed to locate said boundary line in accordance with the report of said boundary line commission; and said Southern Mapping and Engineering Company shall mark said boundary line by appropriate markers or monuments at every half mile along said boundary line and at every public road intersection; said markers to be furnished by Guilford County and Randolph County, each county paying one half of the expenses.

And Southern Mapping and Engineering Company is authorized and directed to make a map showing said boundary line as settled and fixed by the report of the said Boundary Line Commission and of the adjoining tracts of land; and to furnish a copy of said map to each of the counties of Guilford and Randolph. Said Southern Mapping and Engineering Company is also authorized and directed to make a report of their action in performing the work aforesaid, and to include in said report a proper legal description of the boundary line between Guilford and Randolph counties in accordance with the report of the Boundary Line Commission.

That the kind of markers shall be designated by the Chairman of the Boards of the County Commissioners of Guilford and Randolph counties but the number of markers shall not exceed one hundred ten (110) and the price of each marker shall not exceed \$7.50.

That Southern Mapping and Engineering Company shall receive for its compensation for the work required of it \$1600.00 and it shall be paid in equal shares by Guilford and Randolph counties.

That Guilford and Randolph counties by their respective chairmen shall execute a written contract with the Southern Mapping and Engineering Co. in accordance with the terms of this resolution.
